I'm Not a Business Why Do I Need an SBA Loan? Low-interest disaster loans from the U.S. Small Business Administration are the number one source of federal disaster recovery funds for homeowners, renters and businesses of all sizes. If referred to SBA it's important to apply to continue your recovery process. sba.gov/disaster

Do I Need to be Home for My FEMA Inspection? Yes, if you have a scheduled inspection, please make sure you are at home. FEMA Inspectors will meet you there. An inspection is needed to keep your recovery on track.

Do I have to Pay Back a FEMA Grant? The money FEMA provides to disaster survivors are grants which do not have to be repaid.

Houses of Worship may be eligible for reimbursement of emergency response, debris removal and restoration costs of disaster damage. For more information contact KY Division of Emergency Management, or email pa.help@KY-em.org
